Sprinter M.R. Poovamma has made it to her second Olympic Games, qualifying this time as a member of the women's 4x400m relay team. Rani Rampal, the Indian hockey team's star forward, has already scored a goal in their first match, as part of the women's team that has made history by qualifying for the Olympics after 36 long years! And Kidambi Srikanth, supported by the foundation since 2012, will look to clinch a podium finish in men's singles in badminton.
